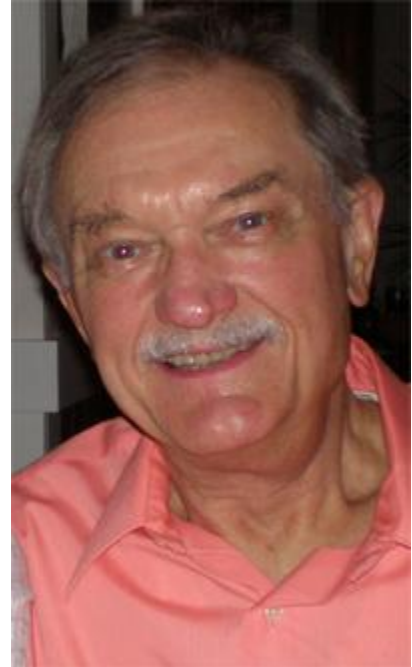
He served in the United States Navy from 1955 to 1964. He served on the Oriskany CV-34, flying F-8E Crusaders.
